#### AMERICANS MOST VALUE FREEDOM OF SPEECH

Freedom of speech is the most important constitutional right, according to a recent survey from *FindLaw.com*. They asked 1,000 American adults to rank the rights enumerated in the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights in order of importance:

A. Freedom of the press: 2%

B. Criminal trial rights: 4%

C. Protection against unreasonable search & seizure: 5%

D. Protection against cruel & unusual punishment: 6%

E. Voting rights: 10%

F. Free exercise of religion: 11%G. Right to keep and bear arms: 12%

H. Due process rights: 20%

I. Freedom of speech: 30%

Poll results varied among age groups. For example, older people tend to place more importance on due process rights and the right to bear arms, while younger people place more importance on freedom of speech and protection against cruel and unusual punishment.
