AMERICA'S TOP LAW FIRMS CONTINUE TO ESTABLISH GOLD STANDARD FOR LGBT WORKPLACE INCLUSION

The nation's top law firms continue to set the standard for LGBT workplace inclusion, according <u>to this recent report</u> by the Human Rights Campaign (HRC) Foundation, the educational arm of the nation's largest lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) civil rights organization.

This year, participation in the Corporate Equality Index (CEI) increased to 156 law firms, representing a majority of *The American Lawyer* publication's list of the nation's 200 top-grossing firms. The CEI, begun in 2002, began rating law firms in 2006.
