Apple Goes Tiny with MacBook Air

Apple recently introduced the world's thinnest notebook, MacBook Air, which measures an unprecedented 0.16 inches at its thinnest point.

MacBook Air has a 13.3-inch LED-backlit widescreen display, a full-size and backlit keyboard, a built-in iSight video camera for video conferencing, and a spacious trackpad with multi-touch gesture support so users can pinch, rotate, and swipe. The computer is powered by a 1.6 GHz or 1.8 GHz Intel Core 2 Duo processor with 4MB L2 cache, and includes as standard features 2GB of memory, an 80GB, 1.8-inch hard drive, and the latest 802.11n Wi-Fi technology and Bluetooth 2.1.

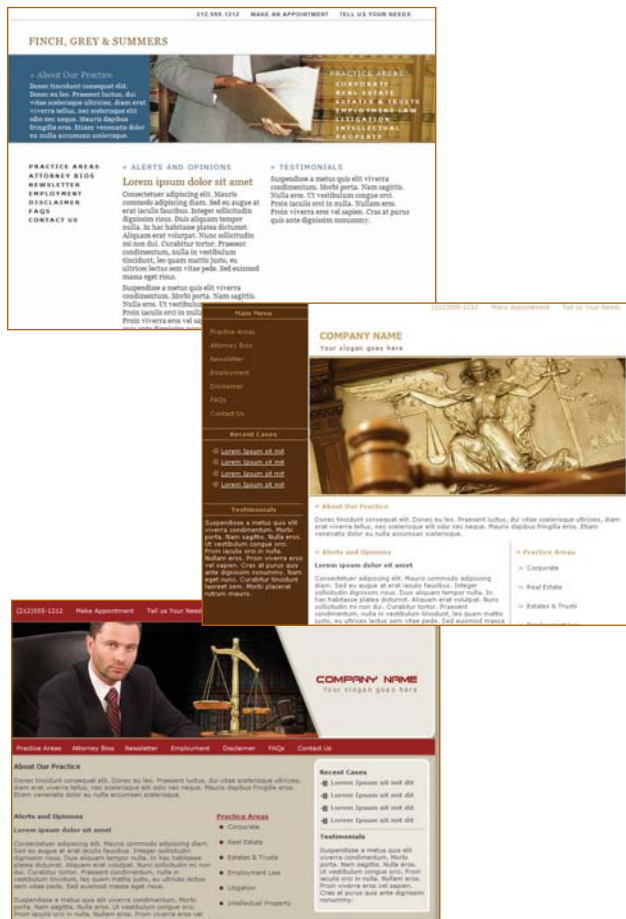

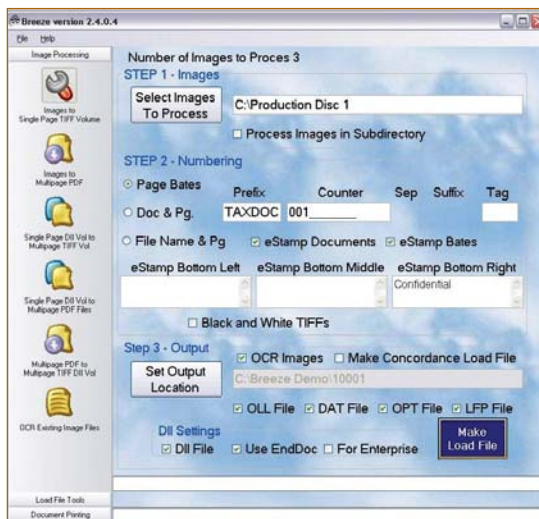
